Here are some tips to help you to complete your Section F: Issues to be Addressed'

'Issues' pertains to any gaps in your knowledge or skills as a practitioner due to never having worked in Australia before.

Please refer to the [Australian OT Standards and Core Competencies](#) to guide you on which core competencies to address.

Try to consider what the differences there might be between your current practice and practising in Australia and how you will need to adapt your practice accordingly.

Aspects of your practice that are likely to be different include:

- Where you work (hospital versus community)
- Cultural groups you haven't worked with before
- Working in private practice
- Australian legislation
- Employer practices and policies
- Digital systems
- Funding systems
- Health & disability services
